



Elementary II Summer Work Activities

We hope you are all having a great start to your summer! Attached you will find your summer reading, language, and math activities to complete before the start of school.

There will be four components to your homework:

- Read three books – ***For each of the two books that you read on your own, please write a minimum of one page stating the title and the author, discuss the main characters, the setting, the plot, and your opinion of the book.***
 - ***All Class Read:** Hidden Figures Young Readers' Edition by Margot Lee Shetterly
- Complete language packet. This is a review of some of the concepts you learned throughout the school year. A Wordly Wise unit is also included for the 4th and 5th years; please practice completing each section according to the directions outlined in the assignment.
- Every student should pick a song that they identify with or that motivates them. List the song and singer and then write at least one side of a paper on why you like this song and how you relate to it. This will be used as a community-building activity at the start of the new school year.
- Complete the math practice sheets. If you do roughly one per week, they should be easy to complete by the end of the summer. They will review skills you practiced in school this past year and make sure you are ready to begin new work in the fall. Please make sure your answer to the riddle or question makes sense! This is the way you can check your own work. If you need help on a problem, you can get help from a friend or family member or look up an instructional website (with a parent's help).
