



## Kindergarten Supply List and Topics

We are asking for Kindergarten families to contribute to our “community supply”.

### **Supplies:**

2 boxes containing 8 markers (1 box of thick, 1 box thin both odor free)

8 large glue sticks

No need to label these items as they will be shared throughout the classroom as needed. The school will provide pencils, erasers, scissors, clipboards, and crayons.

**World Languages:** Please send in 1 pocket folder, with your child’s name on the front.

### **Backpacks:**

A regular backpack will be suitable for our travels and sized perfectly for our cubbies in the Children’s House classrooms. *Please, do not buy rolling backpacks*

### **Photos:**

Kindergarten children will be making a photo family tree as they learn “all about me” the first month of school. To do this, they will need photos of each parent, each sibling, and a photo of themselves. You may also send in grandparent pictures if you want the family tree to show another generation. Please, do not send in additional family members (pets, cousins, aunts, great-grandparents as our primary focus will be on immediate family). **These photos should come in during the first few weeks of school.** Please write the name of the person in the photo on the back of the picture. It is essentially important that the names are clear enough for your child to copy. Enclose photos in an envelope with your child’s name and “Kindergarten Photos” so Children’s House teachers will know to leave them in backpack for Kindergarten teachers.

### **Lunch:**

During lunchtime, we will reinforce appropriate manners, social skills, and eating habits

### **Field Trips and Guest Speakers:**

Starting in October, we will either go on field trips, or we will invite guest speakers to our classroom. Permission slips will be sent home via backpacks and e-mail. Please check your e-mail periodically for important information, reminders, and updated studies throughout the year.
